Cincinnati Standoff Ends Peacefully

Appanoose County— On Tuesday, August 12, 2014 at approximately 3:40 a.m. the Appanoose County Law Center received a report of two adult brothers arguing at 205 E. Pleasant Street in Cincinnati. The caller reported that during the argument gun shots were heard and one of the men had indicated he had been shot.

As Law Enforcement arrived at the location one of the adult males left the residence and the second adult male displayed a dangerous weapon and threatened a Deputy Sheriff. The male then barricaded himself inside the residence with multiple weapons.

During the standoff the adult male inside the residence threatened to shoot Law Enforcement Officers.

During tense negotiations with the adult male inside the residence, the male was convinced to surrender himself to Law Enforcement Officers. At approximately 5:12 a.m. the male was taken into custody and transported to a local hospital for evaluation.

Charges are pending against the adult male inside the residence. The other brother was located and found to be unharmed.

Several weapons were removed from the residence. The Appanoose County Sheriff was assisted by the Centerville Police, Iowa State Patrol Tactical Team & Hostage Negotiator, Centerville Fire, Mercy Ambulance, Davis County Sheriff, and City of Cincinnati.

A criminal charge is merely an accusation and the defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty in a court of law.
